SWEDISH FOOD IMPORTS FROM ETHIOPIA

This market brief focuses on Swedish imports of foodstuffs from Ethiopia, whether imported directly or through another EU-country. For general information about the Swedish food market as well as food imports to Sweden, see our survey "Market Report: Food", published in 2013.

SWEDISH MARKET

Sweden is since 1995 a member of the European Union (EU), which from 2013 has 28 member states. The population of Sweden is close to 10 million, which means that the Swedish market accounts for about 2% of the total EU market.

Due to the country's northern location and it's temperate climate, about 40-45% of all food products consumed are imported.

FOOD IMPORTS FROM ETHIOPIA

Raw coffee accounts for 97-98% of all direct imports from Ethiopia to Sweden. Only a few other product are imported on a regular basis, mainly teff injera bread and herbs.

However, if all products that originate in Ethiopia are included, also those imported via trading houses in other EU-countries, the imported volume should be higher. One of the most important food products imported via other channels within the EU, are leguminous vegetables.

In 2012, the value of food imports from Ethiopia to Sweden amounted to \clubsuit 27 million, 23% less than in 2011, but 20% higher than in 2010. The high increase is to a large extent due to high international prices. The same year, Ethiopian food exports to the EU amounted to \clubsuit 376 million. The main export items were raw coffee (87%), leguminous vegetables, both fresh and dried (9%) and oil seeds (3%).

COFFEE

With a share of about 6-7%, Ethiopia is normally among the top suppliers of raw coffee to the Swedish market. The popularity of Ethiopian coffee can in part be attributed to the fact that almost all coffee imports into Sweden consist of the Arabica type, the only type exported from Ethiopia.

Besides ordinary blends, Ethiopian coffee is also sold and marketed as single origin coffee, of which the most popular varieties are sold under the trade names Sidamo Ethiopia, Yirgachefe Ethiopia and Harar Ethiopia.

Of special interest is also the growing importance of certified organic and Fairtrade varieties, which now account for about 10% of all Swedish coffee imports.

During 2012, Swedish imports from Ethiopia amounted to 6,600 tonnes in volume and €26 million in value. The same year, EU imports amounted to approx. 96,000 tonnes (equalling €328 million).

FRUIT AND VEGETABLES

Swedish imports of Ethiopian fruit and vegetables are chiefly channeled through trading companies in other EU countries.

Ethiopian exports to Europe mainly consist of green beans and peas (primarily haricot beans, horse beans, pea-beans, chick peas). In addition, small quantities of strawberries, and cherry tomatoes, bell peppers, okra, melon, mangoes, passion fruits and papayas, are also exported.





HERBS AND SPICES

EU imports of herbs and spices from Ethiopia presently consist of various types of fresh herbs, such as chives, basil, coriander, oregano, tarragon, and mint. A few of these varieties are also imported directly to Sweden.

Recently, also seasonings used in Ethiopian cuisine, such as blended chili pepper (berbere), mitmita (red chili powder) awaze (red chili paste), as well as other traditional seasonings, have started to be imported into the EU.

BREAD AND CEREAL PRODUCTS

According to official import data, Sweden account for a very large share of Ethiopia's export of cereal based products to the EU. Furthermore, imports of cereal products concern mainly one product - injera - Ethiopian sourdough flatbread made from teff flour.

The injera is imported to Sweden directly by airfreight from Ethiopia. Main customers are Ethiopian restaurants and ethnic food stores, both in Sweden and other Nordic countries.

OTHER FOOD PRODUCTS

Other food products imported into Europe includes oilseeds, especially sesame seeds, natural honey, and natural gum (used for food industrial and pharmaceutical purposes).

MARKET PROSPECTS

Increased interest in Ethiopian cuisine could open new opportunities for exporters, not just of Ethiopian high quality coffee, and by-products of teff, but also for other traditional Ethiopian foods, in the form of sauces, spices and bread.

With the long growing season, proximity to European market and availability of a large number of different fruits and vegetables, as well as the expansion of food processing industries, Ethiopia has potential for a substantial increase of food exports, both to the EU and Sweden.
